PARKS FORWARD COMMISSION MEETING ON OCTOBER 21, 2015 SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA

Commission to Ensure the Long-Term Sustainability of the State Park System to Assess Implementation of Commission's Final Recommendations

The Parks Forward Commission will hold its seventh meeting on **October 21**, **2015**, **from 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.** at the California State Railroad Museum in Old Sacramento (125 I Street, Sacramento, CA, 95814). The public is welcome to attend.

In February 2015, the 12-member Parks Forward Commission adopted its longterm plan for a financially sustainable and relevant California State Park System. The recommendations were developed after nearly two years of outreach and study that included public meetings, discussions with State Parks leadership and staff, surveys, social media interaction, and independent analyses conducted for the Commission. Responding to the recommendations, the Department of Parks and Recreation created a Transformation Team to lead the transformation effort for the Department.

At its October 21 meeting, the Commission will review the status of implementation of its recommendations. (An agenda is available <u>here</u>.) Department Director Lisa Mangat will update the Commission on the Department's transformation efforts. There will also be an opportunity for public comment. The Commission will discuss implementation to date, and will issue a report summarizing its findings after the meeting.
